

# CALHOUN Scholarships

Students seeking any of the scholarships listed below from Calhoun Community College must submit both the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and a scholarship application by March 1st. Scholarship students must attend Calhoun full-time during fall and spring semesters (minimum of 12-hours or the contact equivalent). Below you will find eligibility criteria for each scholarship.

**Presidential Honors Program Scholarship:** The criteria for this scholarship is determined by the Honors Program coordinators in conjunction with the Scholarship Committee. This scholarship will cover full tuition and fees up to 15 credit hours for fall and spring semesters. This scholarship is guaranteed for two years as long as the student remains in the Presidential Honors Program.

**Academic Scholarship\*:** This scholarship is available to any student (incoming or current). Awardees are selected by a multidisciplinary scholarship committee. Preference is given to students with GPAs of 3.0 or higher. ACT scores are taken into consideration when awarding high school seniors. This is a one-year scholarship for \$2,000 (\$1,000 per semester).

**Principal's Choice Awards\*:** Each eligible high school in our service area receives one Principal's Choice Award. This is a one-year scholarship for \$1,500 (\$750 per semester). Eligibility is contingent upon a 3.0 GPA and ACT score of 20 or higher. Nominations from the high school principal/counselor must be submitted to the Scholarship Office by March 1st.

**Valedictorian and Salutatorian Scholarship\*:** The top 2 students graduating from eligible high schools in our service area can receive a one-year scholarship for \$1,000 (\$500 per semester). Student eligibility is contingent upon a 3.0 GPA and ACT score of 20 or higher. Val/Sal scholarship recipients are responsible for self-notifying the scholarship office of their graduating rank by providing an official transcript that includes class rank to the scholarship office by June 15th to confirm their ranking. If a valedictorian or salutatorian claim this award from a high school, then the high school cannot nominate a student for a Top 5% Scholarship.

**Top 5% Scholarship\*:** One student graduating from eligible high schools in our service area can receive a one-year scholarship for \$1,000 (\$500 per semester). Student eligibility is contingent upon a 3.0 GPA and ACT score of 20 or higher. Nominations from the high school principal/counselor must be submitted to the Scholarship Office by March 1st. Eligible high schools are permitted either the Valedictorian and Salutatorian Scholarship or the Top 5% Scholarship.

*\* The institutional scholarships noted may be stacked to cover tuition and fees up to 12 credit hours. These scholarships can be stacked with other institutional scholarships, but cannot exceed the amount of tuition and fees. To be eligible for the spring portion of any award students must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA and complete at least 12 credit hours.*
